DWEJ CEO featured on national webinar to promote walkable communities

*Guy Williams shares leadership experience from the environmental justice
movement for America Walks' 2016 Walking College webinar series*

DETROIT – **Guy Williams**, president and CEO of **Detroiters Working for Environmental Justice** today led a presentation on developing leadership for walkable communities as part of a webinar series hosted by **America Walks**. The presentation was directed at 25 Walking College Fellows, who are part of the **2016 Walking College**. The program teaches advocacy and leadership skills for promoting walkable communities throughout the United States. Williams shared experiences and insights he gained from decades of being on the front lines of the environmental justice movement.
